As a peer-reviewed interdisciplinary journal of science and technology, PJST seeks to provide a platform for research, observations, theories, and communications from both inside and outside of Akamai University.

PJST is published in an electronic format, semi-annually at the end of May and November. To be considered for inclusion into PJST, submissions must be received no later than one-month before the publication date. The editors of PJST extend an open invitation to the global scientific community and encourage you to consider submitting your articles for publication. The topic matter of the journal is very broad and interdisciplinary in nature. We will consider any referenced article or communication related to the many disciplines of science and technology.

For the Spring 2010 Edition, papers must be submitted according to the format detailed in the submission guidelines. The submission window for the Spring edition will open on 15 January 2010 and end once 50 papers have been accepted for publication. Notification that the submission window is closed will be posted on this page. No papers will be held over for the Fall edition. Manuscripts submitted after the closing of the Spring submission window must be re-submitted to be considered for publication in the fall 2010 edition.
